### What you need to know about taking the HESI

- Cost of HESI is \$65 made payable in the business office (price is subject to change)
- All HESI tests need to be scheduled through the SSC testing department.
- Please schedule your HESI Exam two weeks prior to testing date.
- Students must present photo ID to the test.

### LPN to RN Eligibility

Licensed practical nurses interested in applying for admission to the SSC RN program should arrange an advising session with the director of the SSC Nursing Program. The purpose of this session is to assess the student's eligibility for LPN to RN options and to develop a curriculum plan consistent with LPN to RN admission standards and post-admission requirements.

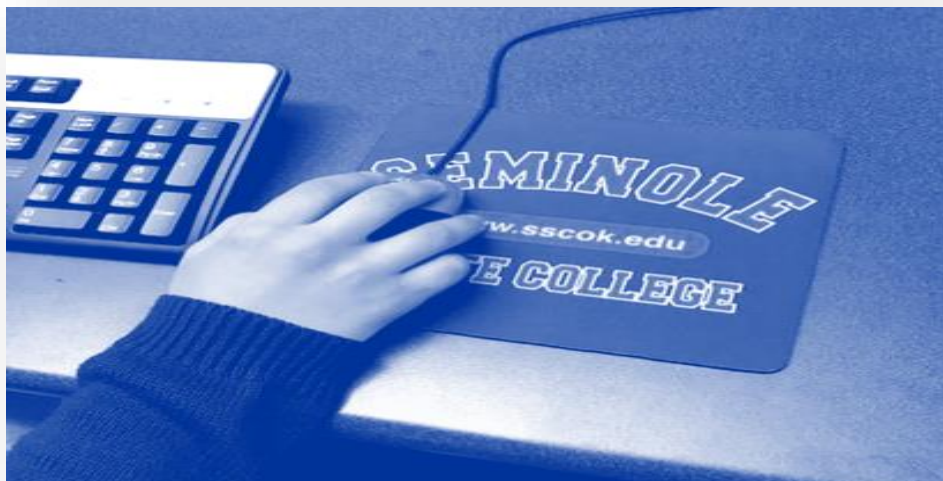
### LPN to RN Admission Standards

In order to use the LPN to RN Advanced Standing Option for admission to the Seminole State College Nursing Program, students must satisfy the minimum admission standards for all applicants and the following additional LPN to RN admission standards.

- a. Graduation from a State Board of Nursing approved School of Practical Nursing and possession of a current unencumbered, unrestricted license from the Oklahoma State Board of Nursing. Licensure documentation must be submitted with application materials prior to published application deadline.

AND

- b. **Competency score of 850 or greater on SSC HESI Nursing Competency Exam taken within the past five years (LPN to RN). Exam may be taken three times, no less than 30 days apart.** HESI results documentation must be submitted with application materials prior to published application deadline.

# CLEP

## How the CLEP Program Works

The College Board's College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) has been the most widely trusted credit-by-examination program for over 40 years, accepted by [2,900 colleges and universities](#) and administered in more than [1,800 test centers](#). This rigorous program allows students from a wide range of ages and backgrounds to demonstrate their mastery of introductory college-level material and earn college credit. Students can earn credit for what they already know by getting qualifying scores on any of the 33 examinations.

While CLEP is sponsored by the College Board, only colleges may grant credit toward a degree. Not all colleges have the same CLEP policies—some colleges accept credit for a few exams, while others accept credit for all of them. A college often grants the same amount of credit to a student who earns satisfactory scores on a CLEP examination as it does for a student who successfully completes the related course.

## What you need to know

- Students need to register for the CLEP exam of their choice at <https://clep.collegeboard.org>. The current fee for a CLEP exam is \$85 made payable on the college board website at the time of registration. (CLEP fee will be \$87 effective July 1, 2018)
- An additional \$15 fee to SSC is made payable in the business office (Room 145) located in the Ben and Bonnie Walkingstick Student Services Building.
- Before registering from the CLEP on the College board website, students must make an appointment for the exam with the testing coordinator at least two weeks before desired test date.
- Appointments may be scheduled by phone (405-382-9576), email ([t.jones@sscok.edu](mailto:t.jones@sscok.edu)) or by visiting the testing center in room 161 of the Ben and Bonnie Walkingstick Student Services Building.
- Students must present a Valid photo ID (State ID, Passport or military ID) and a printed copy of CLEP Exam Registration Ticket to testing staff before testing.
- No electronic devices or bags of any kind are allowed in the CLEP room. All belongings are to be stored in the lockers located in the testing office, this includes hoodies and coats.

# Simple Steps to Placement Testing

- Fill out Admissions application at <http://sscok.edu>
- Meet with an Academic advisor and receive a placement testing form.
- Come to room 161 in the Ben and Bonnie Walkingstick student services center to test.
- Allow yourself two hours to complete the placement exam.
- Return to academic advisor to enroll in classes.

Please bring all documents relating to your education with when you come to enroll.

The SSC Testing Center serves as a site for academic proctoring originating from other institutions.

The proctoring fee is \$15 per test.
