### Certificate Program Objective

The objective of the Early College Certificate is to encourage concurrent high school students and college-bound Career Tech students to complete eighteen hours of college credit prior to entering the workforce or college full time. In so doing, students have the opportunity to gain confidence-building collegiate experience that will facilitate the pursuit and completion of a two-year or four-year college degree. Oklahoma Career Tech graduates holding the certificate in addition to their technical certificate will have a competitive advantage in the employment marketplace.

### Requirements for Certification

1. At least eighteen designated semester credit hours.
2. Grade of "C" or better required in all Certificate Requirement courses.
3. Grade Point Average of 2.0 or better.
4. Six semester credit hours in attendance at SSC.
5. Completion of Graduate Exit Survey.
