The objective of the Secondary Education Associate in Science – History Teacher Certification Emphasis is to prepare students for transfer to a bachelor's degree granting institution to major in history with a concentration in teacher certification.

Requirements for Graduation

- 1. Sixty-two designated semester credit hours.
- 2. Grade of "C" or better required in all Major Field Requirement courses.
- 3. Grade Point Average of 2.0 or better.
- 4. Fifteen semester credit hours in attendance at SSC.
- 5. Completion of Graduate Exit Survey.
