

Academic Affairs Advanced Placement Credit

The Advanced Placement (AP) Program allows high school student to take formal examinations for course credit at the college level. AP examination are arranged through high school counselors. This table lists the AP examinations for which SSC awards credit, and the course IDs of the courses for which credit is awarded based on the exam score (3, 4 or 5). The last digit of the numerical portion of each course ID represents the number of credit hours earned when a student earns credit for the course.

SSC does not award credit for AP exams scores of 1 and 2.
