

ENGLISH COMPOSITION PLACEMENT GUIDELINES AND CUT SCORES

Eligibility for ENG 1113: English Composition I

Students may enroll directly in ENG 1113 if they meet **one** of the following:

- A cumulative, unweighted high school GPA of **3.0 or higher** (within the past 3 years).
- A cumulative, unweighted GPA below 3.0 (or GPA not available/older than 3 years) **and** one of the following standardized test scores:
 - **Accuplacer**: 250 or higher
 - **ACT English**: 19 or higher
 - **ACT Writing**: 8 or higher

Co-requisite Placement

Students who do not meet either criterion above must enroll in the **Co-requisite Option**:

- **ENG 1113 (Composition I) + ENG 0203 (Composition Lab)**
- *Note: Beginning Fall 2026, ENG 0203 will transition to a 2-credit course (ENG 0202), but the course title will remain "Composition Lab."*

Advanced Placement (AP) Credit

Students may earn credit through the AP English Language and Composition exam:

- **Score of 3** → Credit for ENG 1113 (student may then enroll in ENG 1213)
- **Score of 4 or higher** → Credit for both ENG 1113 and ENG 1213
