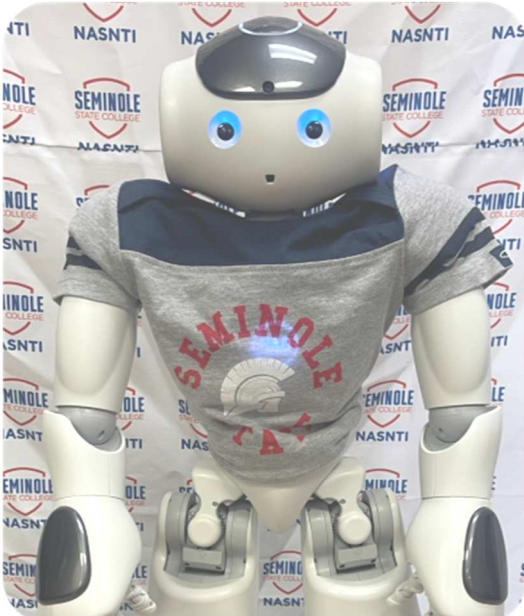


“Hi! Welcome to Seminole State College!”

Who is NAO? NAO is a programmable humanoid robot widely used in education and research. It can recognize speech, synthesize voice, and interact with users—making it a powerful tool for learning and engagement.

What are we doing? In collaboration with the SSC Computer Science Script Programming (Python) course, students will program NAO to understand and speak Native American languages from the Citizens Potawatomi Nation and Sac and Fox Nation.

Spring 2026 Project Focus: Students in the Script Programming class will work throughout the semester to teach NAO beginner-level language skills, guided by materials from Native American linguists. The learning levels include:

- Level 1—Alphabet
- Level 2—Commands
- Level 3—Common Household Phrases
