- 1. Why you should be selected as a scholarship recipient.
- 2. Your academic goals and aspirations.

SSC Academic Scholarships
□ SSC Academic Scholarship — up to \$4,000 over four semesters (\$1,000 per fall/spring semester). Students who attend SSC who have achieved a minimum ACT score of 19 OR a minimum high school/collegiate GPA of 3.0. Amount of scholarship will be based on merit. Student must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA and full time status.
□ Valedictorian Scholarship - \$5,000 over four semesters (\$1,250 per fall/spring semester). Students who attend SSC who have been named Valedictorian of their high school and a minimum ACT score of 21 or higher. Student must maintain a minimum 3.2 GPA and full time status.
□ Salutatorian Scholarship - \$4,000 over four semesters (\$1,000 per fall/spring semester). Students who attend SSC who have been named Salutatorian of their high school and a minimum ACT score of 19 or higher. Student must maintain a minimum 3.2 GPA and full time status.
☐ Glen Johnson Academic Scholarship — up to \$2,000 over two semesters (\$1,000 per fall/spring semester). Students who attend SSC who have achieved a minimum ACT score of 19 OR a minimum high school/collegiate GPA of 3.0. Student must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA and full time status to retain this award. Two students will be selected for this award each year.

☐ Agricultural Science Scholarship - \$1,000 over two semesters (\$500 per fall/spring semester). Applicants must major in Agricultural Science. Outstanding leadership and FFA participation required; student must maintain a 2.5 or better GPA each semester while being enrolled full-time. <u>A list of FFA activities and awards</u> must be included with this application, along with a letter of recommendation from the high school agriculture teacher.
□ Academic Division Scholarship (please select the division in which your major is under)
□ Language Arts & Humanities □ Social Sciences □ STEM □ Business & Education □ Health Sciences \$1,000 over two semesters (\$500 per fall/spring semester). Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA from high school or college as applicable; must be enrolled full time and must have declared a major within the division in which they are applying for at the time of this application. This scholarship evaluates the submitted essay.
SSC Foundation Scholarships
☐ BP Settlement Foundation Scholarship: Awarded to students enrolled at Seminole State College that demonstrate a need.
□ Calvin Family Scholarship - Covers the cost of tuition for one year divided over two consecutive fall and spring semesters.
□ Dan Wallace Scholarship: High school seniors who graduated from Seminole High School and will attend SSC. First priority is given to students based on academic performance and ACT scores. Scholarship covers the cost of tuition for one year.
□ Edwin & Helen Roesler Scholarship: Entering Freshman. First priority is given to residents of Seminole and Seminole HS graduates. Second priority is given to a resident of Seminole County. Scholarship covers tuition, fees and books for up to two years.
☐ Elsie Morris Scholarship: Awarded to students enrolled at Seminole State College that demonstrate need.
□ Eloise Wright Nursing Scholarship: Second year nursing students may apply for the scholarship, providing the student maintains academic achievement.
☐ Jimmie & Marie Austin Scholarship: Students of Seminole County Oil industry families preferred. Scholarship covers tuition, fees & books for up to two years
☐ Kelton Wantland Scholarship: First priority is given to Seminole Speech or Debate student. Scholarship is for \$500 for one semester.
□ Langley Family Scholarship: Students of Seminole and Pottawatomie counties; based on academic performance; school/civic/community involvement and need. Scholarship is for \$1,000 divided over two consecutive fall and spring semesters.
□ Warren Lindley Scholarship: First priority is given to students who represent under-represented, minority and socio-economic classes.
☐ Mickey Burgess Memorial Scholarship: Awarded to SSC Business major students. Scholarship is for \$500 for one semester.
☐ Moran/Kirk Scholarship: Awarded to SSC Art major students. Scholarship is for \$500 for one semester.
☐ Moran Nursing Scholarship: Second year Nursing students may apply for the \$1000 scholarship to be used for <u>TWO</u> semesters, providing the student maintains a nursing major, has a current 3.0 GPA and minimum ACT of 20.
☐ Morgan Family Scholarship: Awarded to a student who attends SSC Scholarship is for \$500 for one semester.
□ Patterson Family Scholarship: Scholarship is for \$1000 divided over two consecutive fall and spring semesters.
□ Paula Rutledge Memorial Scholarship: Awarded to SSC Math major students. Scholarship is for \$500 for one semester.
□ Stanley and Inez Symons Scholarship: Awarded to students enrolled at Seminole State College that demonstrates need.
☐ Sue Woods Scholarship: Awarded to a Medical Lab Technician student for \$1,000 to be used for the summer semester only .
□ Utterback Family Scholarship : Awarded to a student accepted into SSC's Nursing program in the amount of \$1,000 per semester for two semesters.
□ Walkingstick Scholarship: First priority is given to female Native American students. Applicants must be an Oklahoma resident, full time, and carry a 3.0 GPA.

SSC Presidential Leadership Scholarship*

\$10,000 over four semesters (\$2,500 per fall/spring semester), plus the use of books. High school seniors who will attend SSC in the fall may apply for the President's Leadership Class (PLC). **Qualifying candidates must be nominated by their high school.** Preferred Qualifications: Score of 20 or better on ACT, high ranking in his/her graduating class. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required to qualify and remain in good standing in the PLC program. Successful applicants will be **required to live on campus**, be enrolled full-time and actively participate in the leadership program. Deadline: Late January. Call (405) 382-9200 for application and exact date.

Faculty Senate Scholarship

Provides up to \$1250 per semester (fall/spring) that may be applied to SSC tuition or required textbooks charged through the SSC bookstore; SSC students who have completed 24 college credit hours may apply; recommendations and committee interview required; apply in the spring semester. Collegian (Newspaper) Scholarship

Up to \$4,000 over four semesters (\$1000 per fall/spring semester). Applicants must supply a letter of recommendation and have past experience in journalism/media relations; must be enrolled full-time. Funds will be applied to the cost of attendance. Professional Staff/Kay Edwards Memorial Scholarship: SSC students may apply for a \$500 scholarship to be used during the <u>SUMMER</u> semester. Apply in the spring semester. Contact Melinda Sims at m.sims@sscok.edu for an application.
