## STEM LAB UPGRADES IN ROOM 303



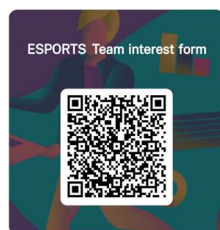
Throughout the five-year program, SSC NASNTI has partnered with the STEM Department to successfully purchase equipment, supplies, educational materials, and renovations to Computer Science Labs. During 2024, the Computer Science Room 202 (Tanner Hall) got a new 'facelift' which included 25 new computers, workstations, and selected equipment and software.

Based on collaborations from SSC IT and the Computer Science Faculty, equipment and supplies included selected styles of computers, monitors, Assistant Network Tester Kit, cables, Fluke Network Cable IQ Advance IT Kit, and Computer Science design wall elements (*inside and outside of the lab*).

Based on a satisfaction survey from two Computer Science classes in 2025, 86% of students would recommend the computer lab to other students, 29% use the lab daily, 71% were very satisfied with the lab updates, 57.1% were satisfied with the gaming monitors, and 57.1% were very satisfied with the gaming chairs.

This year, the partnership will continue with upgrades to the STEM Study Room Lab! Located in Tanner Hall, Room 303, upgrades include: seven Mobile Double-Sided Magnetic Whiteboards, four Height Adjustable Sit/Stand Flipper Table with Whiteboard Top, six 48" Round Table with Markerboard Top, and eighteen 24" curved benches.

The Lab will be finished before the Fall 2026 Semester Starts!
