Multiple Measures English Rubric

Yes: Use score to determine course to take:

- Score 18-22: Take ENG 1113 (Comp I) – College-level English
- Score 14-17: Take ENG 0203 (Special Topics in Comp) with ENG 1113 (Comp I) – College-level English with remediation (must pass both to earn College-level English credit)
- Score 0-13: Take ENG 0125 (Fundamentals of Language Arts)
