

DON GILL FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

Don Gill was a longtime resident of Seminole, OK and was an original member of the faculty of then Seminole “Junior” College. He served many roles at the college including Dean of Students and Speech instructor. Don was a long-time philanthropist in the Seminole community, best known for his work with the Inter-Faith Social Ministry’s food pantry and his membership with the local Rotary club. This scholarship is awarded in memory of Don and in his spirit of giving.

There will be 10 scholarships of \$2,400 awarded (\$600 per semester for 2 years). Students must have a financial need based on information from a current year FAFSA, must earn their high school diploma or an equivalent, must be enrolled full time at Seminole State College, must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better, must be a Seminole County Resident, and must not be participating in collegiate athletics.

Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA and will be required to submit their transcript and proof of enrollment each semester.
